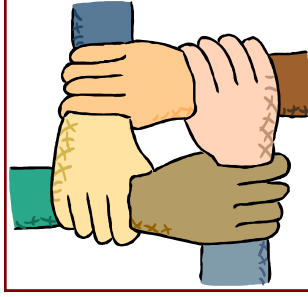

The Massachusetts Department of Public Health established the Community Health Network in 1992. *Community Partners for Health, or CHNA-6* is the designated Community Health Network affiliation for the communities of Bellingham, Blackstone, Douglas, Franklin, Hopedale, Medway, Mendon, Milford, Millville, Northbridge, Sutton, Upton and Uxbridge.

Membership consists of volunteer representatives from health promotion facilities, community-based health organizations, educational facilities, human service organizations, local government, faith communities, local businesses and the general community.

*CHNA-6* general meetings are held at Milford Regional Medical Center from 9 to 11 a.m. on the third Friday of January, March, May, June, September and November.
